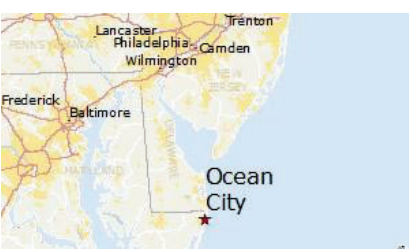


Seacrets Ocean City, MD



Company and Location:

- **Company** – Lively waterfront nightspot with several dance floors, tropical cocktails, & Caribbean vibes.
- **Community** – Atlantic resort town, year round population of about 7000, hosting 8 million + visitors annually!
- **Location** – Part of a barrier island on the East Coast of Maryland. About 150 miles (241 km) SE of Washington, D.C. and 240 miles (386 km) S of New York City.
- **Weather** – Hot during the day, warm during the evening. Average temperatures range between 75 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit (23-38 degrees Celsius)



Job Position:

- **Guest Relations**—Assist guests in many ways including but not limited to grounds up-keep, parking, directions, and rule enforcement (\$15.50/hr). **Prep Cook**—Assist in meal prep, help keep the kitchen clean (\$15.00/hr). **Line Cook**—Prep and cook meals (\$16.00/hr). **Hostess**—Greet guests and seat guests (\$15.00/hr). **AM and PM Comfort Station/Grounds**—Maintain clean facility. Street clean up, trash duty, water plants, beach maintenance(\$15.50/hr) **Cashier**—Balance daily cash & credit card receipts. Able to handle US currency. (\$15.75/hr)
- All positions require standing for the duration of your shift, general restaurant duties as assigned & cleaning safely with chemicals!
- **Hours** – Average 32+ hours per week
- **Start Date:** May 15th or June 15th
- **End Date:** September 15th-30th



Employment Conditions:

- Advanced English skills for interacting with customers with a positive attitude.
- The first 3 weeks will be a training period where the hours may be reduced until you are immersed in your full time schedule.
- Hours and schedule will vary each week, must be available and able to work holidays, weekdays, and weekends (Saturday, Sunday) as scheduled.
- **Uniform** – Logo t-shirt for \$13.00 per shirt, first shirt is free. Must wear closed toe non slip work shoes. No sandals or flip flops.
- **Social Security Number** - Approximately seven days after you check into the program you will apply for a social security card. You will be able to work before you receive your card but you must provide a receipt to prove you have applied.

Housing and Transportation: (all photos below are example only for reference)

Overview of housing situation: Assigned upon arrival in sponsor approved housing in OC. Located in apartment style housing. Expect one bed per person (bunk bed style), shared kitchen, and full bathroom.

- **Housing Fees:** Expect a seasonal rental fee of \$2,800. A starter pack will cost \$50 and reserved housing placement is \$50
- **Additional Housing Fees:** Housing deposit of \$300 and your first rental payment of \$300 will be paid 4 weeks before your arrival. \$250 of your deposit is eligible for refund upon successful program completion, damage inspection, and positive rental obligation standing.

Your landlord/employer will communicate payment schedules with you directly.

- **Transportation** – You will walk/bike/ride share to and from work each day. Public transportation in Ocean City can be utilized for \$4.00 per day. All transportation is your financial responsibility.
- **Bike Safety Reminder** – Always wear a helmet & reflective gear, utilize a blinking light, and obey all traffic signs and lights!
